Dr. Rusakova is the co-founder and current director of the Regional Non-Governmental Organization of Social Projects in the Sphere of Populations' Well-being "Stellit", located in St. Petersburg, Russia. She is also currently the head of the sector of Sociology of Deviance and Social Control in the Sociological Institute of the Russian Academy of Sciences.
